Candice Millard, an acclaimed and award-winning writer of narrative nonfiction, will discuss her four New York Times bestselling books. Stories of courage and determination, ambition and envy, genius and desperation, triumph and regret. She explains the elements of effective storytelling, details her writing process and shares stories from her own, often-harrowing research trips. Her first book, *The* River of Doubt: Theodore Roosevelt's Darkest Journey, was a Barnes & Noble Discover Great New Writers selection and a Book Sense Pick, won the William Rockhill Nelson Award, was a finalist for the Quill Awards, and has been published in multiple foreign editions. *Destiny of the Republic: A Tale of Madness, Medicine &* the Murder of a President, won the Edgar Award for Best Fact Crime, the PEN Center USA award for Research Nonfiction, the One Book-One Lincoln Award, the Ohioana Award, and the Kansas Notable Book Award. Hero of the Empire: The Boer War, a Daring Escape and the Making of Winston Churchill, was an Indie Next pick, a top ten critics pick by the New York Times and named Amazon's number one history book of 2016. Millard's most recent book, released in May of 2022, is River of the Gods: Genius, Courage, and Betrayal in the Search for the Source of the Nile. She is the recipient of the 2017 BIO Award, and her work has appeared in the New York Times Book Review, Washington Post Book World, Guardian, Time Magazine and National *Geographic.* She lives in Kansas City with her husband and three children.

Jeff Corwin

For nearly three decades, Jeff Corwin has been telling stories of wildlife and nature to a global audience through his many celebrated television series on ABC, NBC, Travel Channel, Food Network, Disney Channel, and Discovery Networks. Corwin is currently the creator, executive producer, and presenter of the groundbreaking television series *Wildlife Nation*, broadcasted on ABC. *Wildlife Nation* explores the remarkable story of North American conservation, highlighting heroes working to save endangered species and wilderness, while forging a strong bond between the audience and the natural resources they depend upon. The mission is to empower a diverse community with stories of environmental stewardship,



conservation, and the plight of imperiled wildlife. *Wildlife Nation* is produced in partnership with Defenders of Wildlife, a leader and pioneer in wildlife conservation. Corwin's television work has been awarded with multiple Emmys and the top broadcast industry awards. His very first TV series was the wildly successful *Going Wild with Jeff Corwin* on Disney Channel. His *Animal Planet* series the *Jeff Corwin Experience* was a global sensation. Corwin is also the creator and co-presenter of CNN's groundbreaking documentary *Planet in Peril*, hosted alongside Anderson Cooper and Sanjay Gupta. Corwin is Executive Producer and host of ABC's *Ocean Treks*, five seasons of powerful and compelling stories exploring journeys of culture, adventure, and nature around the globe. Corwin is an Executive Producer and Presenter for the giant screen film *Expedition Chesapeake* and the Narrator for David Attenborough's powerful, cinematic documentary *Galapagos, NaturesWonderland*. During the Gulf oil spill, Corwin served as an environmental correspondent for both CBS and NBC News. In April 2020, Corwin created and executively produced the critically acclaimed TV series *Alaska Animal Rescue* for Nat Geo Wild, now on Disney Plus.

Beyond television, Corwin's acclaimed NBC documentary and book, 100 Heartbeats, engaged both the readers and broadcast audience in the 21st Century plight of endangered species. Corwin is also the author of 10 books on wildlife and nature, including Living on the Edge, Amazing Relationships in the Nature World. Corwin is a leader in conservation, recognized through his work as a television host, producer, journalist, author, explorer, and wildlife biologist. Corwin's education includes Bachelor of Science Degrees in Anthropology and Biology from Bridgewater State University and a Master of Wildlife and Fisheries of Conservation from the University of Massachusetts, Amherst. Corwin is the recipient of numerous Honorary Doctorate Degrees in Education and Environmental Science. His lifelong global exploration, academic training, and partnerships with top scientists allow Corwin exclusive access to the compelling stories from the battlefront of conservation. Corwin's love for adventure and discovery has fueled his lifelong career. He has been striving to change the world one species at a time and leave a vital legacy for future generations.

Molly Bloom

Molly Bloom is an inspirational keynote speaker, entrepreneur, and bestselling author of *Molly's Game*. She is best known for her memoir, *Molly's Game*, which was adapted into an award-winning film of the same name by Aaron Sorkin. Bloom's memoir chronicles her journey from college student to LA waitress to building and operating the largest and most notorious private poker game in the world. Her games featured hundreds of millions of dollars and players like Leonardo DiCaprio, Tobey Maguire, Alex Rodriguez, and Ben Affleck.

Bloom began her career as a world-class skier. While training as a pre-teen she was diagnosed with severe scoliosis and had to undergo surgery that the doctors said would end her athletic career. A year later, fully recovered, she was back on the slopes. She later joined the U.S. Ski Team and at 21 years old was ranked No. 3 in North America in moguls, but her Olympic dreams would go unrealized as she left the team to pursue other projects. This led her to what she thought would be a one-year sabbatical in LA. Bloom was finishing her degree in Political Science from the University of Colorado – Boulder, and was in the process of applying to top tier Law Schools, when her assistant job turned her into an accidental entrepreneur, running one of the most exclusive, high-stakes underground poker games in the world, pulling in as much as \$4 million per year. What happened next is where her story truly begins.



Some of Bloom's engagements include Fortune 1000 and strategic clients such as Comcast and US Bank. The film Molly's Game, written and directed by Aaron

Sorkin, stars Academy Award winner for Best Actress, Jessica Chastain (as Molly), Idris Elba, Kevin Costner, Michael Cera, Brian d'Arcy James, and Chris O'Dowd. Featured on Daily Hive and the New York Times as a 'must watch' movie, *Molly's Game* is now available to stream on YouTube TV.

Bloom has appeared on numerous shows and in media outlets such as *Ellen, Vice, The Los Angeles Times,* NPR, *Vulture,* and has been asked to speak at *Fortune's* Most Powerful Women, for companies like Blackrock Financial, SiriusXM Radio, and delivered the 2018 commencement speech at Colorado State University.

Currently, Bloom is focusing her energy on uplifting and mentoring other women after having been the mentee of amazing, dynamic women herself. In 2020, she launched the One World Group to support women facing various challenges, especially those exacerbated by the global pandemic. In 2022, she launched TORCHED, a new podcast about Olympic controversies.


